Past State Deputy report: In reference to December 7<sup>th</sup>, I learned recently that Admiral Nimitz replaced the Commander at Pearl Harbor Shortly after the bombing. He was asked what he thought about the devastation and said the Japanese had made 3 mistakes: First, they attacked on a Sunday, meaning most personnel were off-base; second, They did not bomb the dry docks which enabled the U.S. to make repairs right there instead of towing ships to the west coast of the Mainland; and third, they did not bomb the oil supply for those ships. Admiral Nimitz looked out amongst the devastation and made positive comments. Relating this to what I see, we have over 1100 members of the 4<sup>th</sup> Degree, yet only a small handful in attendance here tonight. In the positive light, we here are doing the work of 1100 men. So next month ask another 4<sup>th</sup> Degree member to come and attend with you. Also think about returning to the tradition of bringing the Color Corps into the meetings Find yourself a Council Home to hold your meetings. Lastly, start more First Degree teams. We need to promote the positive things in the assembly.
